Crimes in June 2004

1. West End, a burglary though not sure what was taken.
2. Gardner Street, 4 alloy car wheels were stolen from a front drive. They were solid black, with 5 spokes. The outer rim has 80 bolts and the inner rim 18 bolts. These are FAULTY and anyone driving a vehicle with those wheels fitted would have serious problems as one wheel is fractured.
3. Recreation Ground, burnt out wheelie bin and damage to the Play Area again. The Association has asked the Parish Council if we can take charge of locking the gate in the drive to the Recreation Ground and the Play Park. All we catch causing damage on the Recreation Ground will be reported to the Police and Herstmonceux Parish Neighbourhood Watch will push for conviction of the culprits.
4. Chapel Row, a brand new Dyson cleaner was stolen still in its delivery Box.
5. Bagham Lane, a pot of pansies taken from rear garden.
6. Hailsham Road, a hanging basket and two Cosmos plants were stolen From the rear of a property.

Two matching labels, known to the Emergency Services and other care agencies are displayed in your house, one on the outside of your fridge door and the other on the inside of your front door so it is not visible from the outside.
