Small Businesses be Aware

Trading Standards warn of "Health and Safety" scams.

East Sussex Trading Standards Officers are warning small businesses that some publishing companies are trading on fears of the consequences of failure to comply with changes to the Health and Safety Law.

The mail-shots used in the aggressive marketing tactics give a misleading impression as to the requirements of the legislation and imply the letters are from an official source. One such letter describes itself as a "Final Notice" and falsely claims that it is an official notification under the Health and Safety at Work Act. The letter goes on to suggest that in order to comply with Health and Safety law the recipient should send payment of £125 for a "compliance pack". The information they offer to supply is available from the Health and Safety Executive for a fraction of that cost.

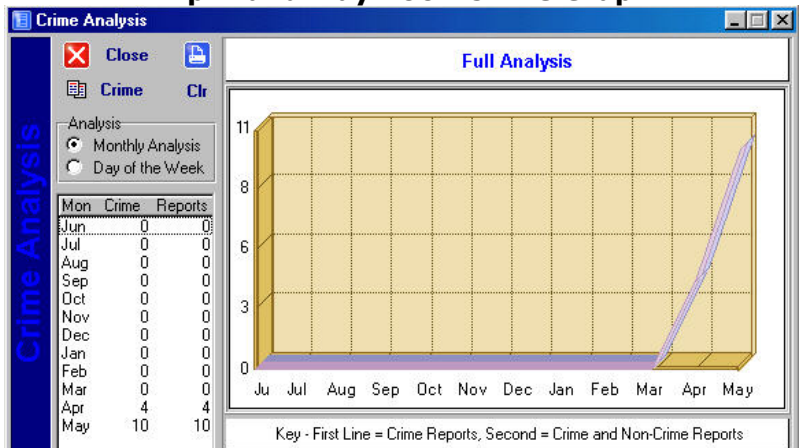

Five of the more serious Crimes in May 2004

1. A window of an elderly resident was broken by a brick in Bagham Lane.
2. The school fence which adjoins the children's play area was vandalised along with the play train in the play area.
3. There has been racist and offensive graffiti sprayed on the skate board equipment in the Recreation Ground.
4. In Windmill Hill, a brown leather shoulder handbag containing credit cards, cash and chequebook was stolen. In
5. The Ridgeway, the measuring tube on the side of an oil tank in a garden was pulled out with the result that 900 - 1000 litres of oil poured out.

Please report any information on these crimes as the damage to areas of the parish costs the Parish Council money. This in turn costs you money as your taxes have to pay for this mindless damage and diverts funds the Parish Council could use on other projects in the parish.
