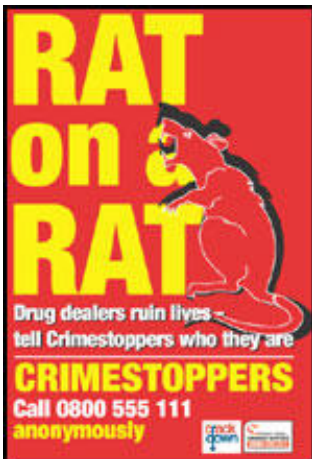

'Rat on a rat' is a new campaign that invites the public to tell the authorities about drug dealers - who they are and where they operate - using the Crimestoppers anonymous phone line 0800 555111.



The campaign will be used throughout Sussex in conjunction with different operations and initiatives to combat the blight caused by drugs.

The information provided by the public could alert the police to a new problem or confirm existing intelligence. Either way, the police can take action to rid the local community of drug dealers and the problems they cause.

Anyone who wants to rat on a rat should phone Crimestoppers on 0800 555111 – you do not have to give your name and you may qualify for a reward.



FIRE KILLS

Most fires start at night and the real killer is smoke. If you are asleep and you don't have a smoke alarm to wake you up, your chances of survival are virtually zero.

While most homes now have smoke alarms, many are unable to do their job properly due to flat or missing

batteries.

1. Check the batteries weekly by pushing the test button until the alarm sounds.
2. Replace the batteries once a year.
3. After 10 years it's best to buy a whole new smoke alarm.



Beeping alarms can be a sign that the battery needs replacing.

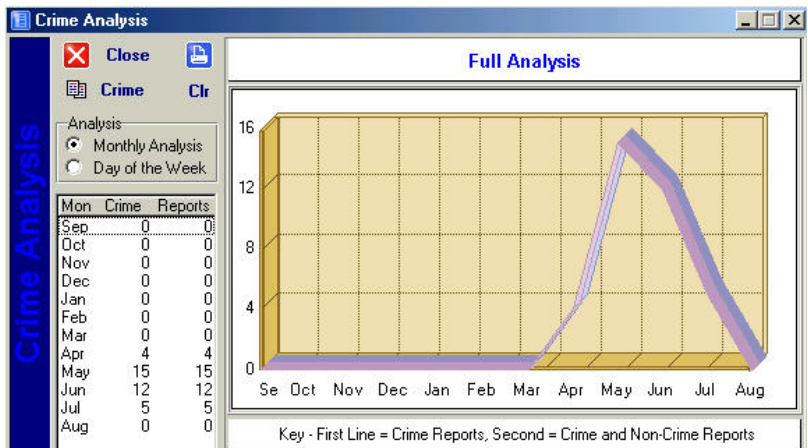

Two matching labels, known to the Emergency Services and other care agencies are displayed in your house, one on the outside of your fridge door and the other on the inside of your front door so it is not visible from the outside.
